

# Nominate your best & brightest 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls to attend Tech Trek!

A week-long Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics (STEM) camp designed to create excitement, interest, and confidence in young women. Tech Trek is a program of the American Association of University Women (AAUW) that is spreading across the nation! It will be held for the third time on the Southwestern Oklahoma State University (**SWOSU**) campus in **Weatherford** and for the first time on the University of Tulsa (**TU**) campus in **Tulsa** in June 2015 (dates to be determined).

## A nominated 7<sup>th</sup> grade girl must:

- Be excited by math or science
- Be motivated to learn
- Have at least a "B" average (is not necessarily the top student)
- Have limited access to programs such as these
- Be likely to benefit from this experience, both academically and personally

#### Personally, the student should:

- Make positive choices for herself, inside and outside of class
- Demonstrate responsibility, honesty, and accountability
- Exhibit self-control and have no serious discipline issues
- Show respect for and cooperate with teachers and students
- Be willing to try new and challenging tasks

# Academically, the student should:

- Be able to follow directions
- Show persistence in task completion
- Participate in class discussions
- Work well in group situations and be willing to help other students
- Be interested in learning and experiencing new things, especially math or science

#### The time line for camper selection is:

- **Mid-February:** Teachers and counselors identify and nominate 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls\*
- Mid-March: Nominated girls submit application
- **Mid-April:** Campers are selected by AAUW members and notified
- **Early May:** Campers register and pay a camp reservation fee of \$50 (non-refundable)
- June 2015: Tech Trek Camp
  \*Girls may only attend one camp (not both)
